



ORDER ON MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiffs, Greg Serbon and John Allen, appeared by counsel, James Bopp, Jr., Defendants, City of East Chicago, IN, City of East Chicago Common Council, Myrna Maldonado, Lenny Franciski, Brenda Walker, Christine Vasquez, Robert Garcia, Gilda Orange, Robert Medina, Emiliano Perez, Kenneth Monroe, Anthony Copeland, City of East Chicago Police Department, and Frank Smith, appeared by counsel, Amy L. Marshak, Nicolas Y. Riley, Candace C. Williams, and Mary B. McCord; and Intervener, State of Indiana, appeared by counsel, Christopher M. Anderson, on March 31, 2021, for hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment filed on August 17, 2018, and Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment filed December 11, 2020. Argument heard. The Court, being duly advised, hereby FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. There is no issue of material fact in that both motions constitute facial challenges to East Chicago Ordinance 17-0010 ("Ordinance") and Ind. Code §5-2-18.2*et seq.*
2. Plaintiffs have standing to bring this action under Ind. Code §5-2-18.2-5 and Ind. Code §5-2-18.2-6.
3. Plaintiffs have failed to prove they have standing to bring this action with respect to their federal constitutional challenge to East Chicago Ordinance 17-0010.

4. East Chicago Ordinance 17-0010 §3, §6(a), and §6(c) violate Ind. Code §5-2-18.2-3.

5. After Plaintiffs commenced this action, the East Chicago Police Department issued its notice in compliance with Ind. Code §5-2-18.2-7.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment and Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment are hereby granted in part and denied in part.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants are hereby enjoined and prohibited from enforcing or otherwise applying East Chicago Ordinance 17-0010 §3, §6(a), and §6(c).
